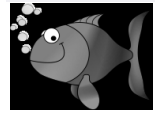
Now is the time of year to start planning your theme basket for our Annual Fourth of July picnic. We are also in need of a **chairperson for this booth** if interested please contact the friary.

We especially need help with the cleanup following the dinner!



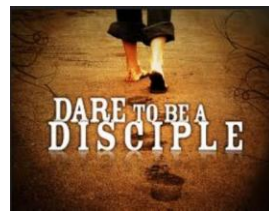
