Lunch at the Reading Terminal Market and dinner at Ralph's, the oldest family owned Italian restaurant in the country. The cost of the trip is \$90.00 per person and INCLUDES dinner at Ralph's, bus transportation, and lots of information on faith, history, and miscellaneous points of interest.
